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POLICY

It is the policy of the Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board that all communications, publications and documents shall be free of language which promotes gender stereotyping, unequal treatment of, or the exclusion of women or men.

Language expresses our thoughts and understandings of inclusion. We promote the use of lifegiving and potential-based language especially when referring to students and staff. The use of inclusive language offers a growth mindset. As an example, instead of saying <u>"an autistic child"</u> we promote rephrasing the reference to <u>"a child with autism"</u>. Each person is created in the image of god and has dignity. Inclusive language changes the focus and guards each person's dignity.
